The Mississippi Department of Revenue (referred to as “DOR” or “Department”) solicited bids to obtain **Permanent and Temporary Disability Placards** for individuals with disabilities for the Motor Vehicles Division. The expiration date for these placards is September 30, 2028.

DOR will contract for these services with a single vendor for a term of sixty (60) months.

DOR released the Permanent and Temporary Disability Placards Invitation for Bid (IFB) # 3160005796 on April 4, 2023. DOR received three (3) sealed bids in response to this IFB. Bids were submitted by the following bidders:

- Elite Textile Trading, LLC
- Image Works Mfg. Inc dba Borden Decal
- Dri-Stick Decal Corp. dba: Rydin

The following bids were evaluated and deemed non-responsive:

- Elite Textile Trading, LLC
- Image Works Mfg. Inc dba Borden Decal

The bid submitted by Dri-Stick Decal Corp. dba Rydin was evaluated and deemed responsive and responsible according to the criteria stated in the solicitation and was, therefore, ranked the highest.

We announce our recommendation to award a contract to the following vendor subject to approval by the Public Procurement Review Board.

- Dri-Stick Decal Corp. dba Rydin- Streamwood, IL

We invite you to contact **Nyla Kendrick, Procurement Officer** if you would like to request a post-award vendor debriefing under Section 7-113 of the PPRB OPSCR Rules and Regulations. This debriefing is a meeting and not a hearing; therefore, legal representation is not required. However, if you prefer to have legal representation present, you must provide notification prior to the scheduled meeting so that we can also have legal representation present. Your request for debriefing must be received within three (3) business days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **May 23, 2023**. MDOR reserves the right to conduct any such debriefing via a teleconference.

Vendors are reminded that any protests of this decision must be submitted to **Nyla Kendrick, Procurement Officer** within seven (7) calendar days after the issuance of this notice or no later than **May 25, 2023**. The protest must be in writing, identify the name and address of the protestor, provide appropriate identification of the procurement and resulting contract number (if known), and detail the nature of the protest, including available supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims.

The successful vendor is instructed not to begin work, purchase materials, or enter into subcontracts relating to the project or services until execution of the contract.
